

Report of the meeting of the Executive Committee of the
Fifth Annual South-Central Renaissance Conference

The Executive Committee of the Fifth Annual South-Central Renaissance Conference met at 7:30 p.m. on Thursday, 12 April 1956, in Room 6, Pleasant Hall, Louisiana State University, Baton Rouge. Present were Albert Howard Carter, President; William S. Burgett, Vice-President and member of the Program Committee; Executive Board members Allen Cataniss and Irving Ribour; members of the Program Committee Waldo F.
