

Executive Council to the conference?

The Executive Council met on 11 April 1957 at 9:00 p.m. at the residence of Mr. James Savage, Oxford, Miss. Present were William Burgess, president; Pansy Paul Morphos, council member; Albert Howard Carter, past president; and Allen Cabaniss, secretary.

The invitation to Texas Christian University in 1958 was confirmed, date to be set near the week-end of 30 March 1958. The meeting for 1959 was set tentatively for Tubane University. An invitation from Southwestern University, Georgetown, Texas, was received for a later year.

A nominating committee consisting of Albert Howard Carter, chairman, Dick Taylor, Jr., and James Savage was appointed. To this committee was given the duty of nominating a president, vice-president, secretary, and two council members for two-year terms, one of whom should be designated to serve for one year as representative of the regional group to the Renaissance Society of America.

Kester Svendsen was appointed to preside at the morning session of 12 April 1957 in the absence of Miss Mary Patchell.
