

SEVENTH ANNUAL MEETING OF THE EXECUTIVE COUNCIL OF
THE SOUTH-CENTRAL RENAISSANCE COUNCIL:

The Executive Council met on 13 March, 1958, 8:30 p.m., at Texas Christian University, Fort Worth, Texas. Present were Kester Svendsen, President; Allen Cabaniss, Vice-President; Lorraine Sherley, Secretary; John E. Uhler, Program Chairman; Patrick Hogan, Council Member; Panos Paul Morphos and Waldo McNeir, Council Members and Regional Representatives of the Renaissance Society of America. Miss Anne Riley could not attend.

The following business was considered:


1) The president entertained suggestions for future meetings, and Waldo McNeir was appointed to inquire into a tentative invitation from Rice Institute for 1959. An invitation from Mississippi State College was received for 1960.

2) A proposal from John E. Uhler that the proceedings of the South-Central Renaissance Conference might attain greater continuity through the appointment of a secretary for three terms was cordially received. A motion that the present secretary, Lorraine Sherley, be retained for a two-year term was duly made, seconded, and passed. (See Amendment no. 5)

3) The problems of drawing into the conference members of disciplines other than English was discussed. All were agreed that a circulating list of prospective writers might be of use, and that young scholars should be invited to submit papers to program chairmen on heretofore neglected topics, such as athletics and military science in the Renaissance.

4) A nominating committee consisting of Dick Taylor, Jr., chairman, and Albert Howard Carter was appointed. To this committee was given the duty of nominating a president and a vice-president, of submitting the name of the secretary for re-election, and of nominating two Council Members for two-year terms, one of whom should be designated to serve for two years as representative of the regional group to the Renaissance Society of America.

There being no further business the meeting adjourned.
