

EIGHTH ANNUAL MEETING

SOUTH-CENTRAL RENAISSANCE CONFERENCE

The meeting of the Executive Council of the Eighth Annual S-CRC was held on 12 March, 1959, 8:30 p.m., at the home of Professor Carroll Camden, Houston, Texas. Present were Waldo McNeir, President; Lorraine Sherley, Secretary; Patrick G. Hogan, Council Member; Frank Halstead, Regional Representative to RSA. Mr. Duane H. D. Roller and Miss Anne Riley, Council Members, could not attend. The following business was transacted:


1.) To a letter from Josephine W. Bennett, Executive Secretary of the RSA, the secretary was instructed to reply that our Conference welcomes the appointment by the RSA of "a young scholar (without academic administrative duties)" to serve for three or more years as representative of the Society in our Regional group.

2.) An invitation to the S-CRC from the Southern Humanities Conference to become a Constituent Member of their group was entertained. On the recommendation of President McNeir, the Council voted that the invitation be accepted and that the annual dues of \$10.00 be paid out of registration fees.

3.) The invitation to Mississippi State ^{University, State College, Mississippi,} College, Starkville, Mississippi, for the Ninth Annual S-CRC was confirmed by Patrick G. Hogan, date to be set near the middle of March, 1960. An invitation from Southwestern University, Georgetown, Texas, was received for the Conference of 1961.

4.) A nominating committee, consisting of S. H. Henderson (English) North Texas State College, Denton, Chairman, and Allen Cabaniss (History) University of Mississippi, Oxford, was appointed. To this committee was given the duty of nominating a president, vice-president, secretary, and two council members for a two-year term, and one Regional Representative to the RSA for a two-year term.

The meeting adjourned at 9:45 p.m.
