Tenth Annual Meeting
of the Executive Council
of the South-Central Renaissance Conference

The meeting of the Executive Council of the Tenth Annual S-CRC was held on 9 March, 1961, 8:30 p.m., in the club-room, Stagecoach Inn, Salado, Texas. The following members were present: Patrick G. Hogan, Jr., President; Carl Hammer, Jr., Vice President; Lorraine Sherley, Secretary-Treasurer and constituent Delegate to the Southern Humanities Conference; William S. Burgett, Regional Representative to the Renaissance Society of America; Leighton Rudolph and Louis A. Schuster, Council Members; and Frederick E. Gaupp, Program Chairman. The following business was transacted:

- 1) The minutes of the 1960 meeting were read and approved
- 2) President Hogan announced that seven or eight papers read at the Ninth Annual S-CRC Conference will be published in the spring issue of the Mississippi Quarterly, 1961. The editor hopes that a presentation copy will be available to each member of S-CRC; however, should the pagination exceed the current fund of the Quarterly, each copy will be sent with a statement enclosed for seventy-five cents (\$.75). A member who desires a copy or copies should give his name to the secretary of S-CRC.

3) The assessment of Registration fees and membership dues was discussed. Professor Gaupp moved that the customary registration fee of one dollar (\$1.00) and other fees for luncheon, dinner... should be collected by the host institution; and that membership dues should not be collected from faculty and students of the host institution who attend an annual conference. Professor Hammer seconded the motion. The motion carried. Professor Schuster then moved that the method of collecting annual dues from the members of S-CRC should be left to the secretary, and that the office hereafter be held by an Executive Secretary-Treasurer. Professor Burgett seconded the motion. The motion carried.


4) President Hogan reported on the SHC, Hollins College, Roanoke, Virginia, March 17-19, 1960, which he attended in behalf of Carroll Camden, the Constituent Delegate of S-CRC. He also reported that annual dues of ten dollars (\$10.00) for 1960 had been allocated from the registration fee of the Ninth Annual S-CRC; whereupon Professor Burgett moved that the secretary be instructed to pay the dues for 1961 from the treasury of S-CRC. The motion, seconded by Professor Randolph, carried.

5) Professor Burgett, who represented the S-CRC at the Advisory Council of RSA, January, 1960, reported that members are requested to write to their Senators and Representatives urging that the NDEA support the Humanities as well as other disciplines. He also reported that each regional group is requested to appoint two representatives to RSA.

6) The invitation of the University of Oklahoma, renewed through Professor Burgett, was accepted for the Eleventh Annual S-CRC to be held on the first or second week-end of March, 1962.

7) President Hogan appointed the following nominating committee: Carroll Camden, Rice University, Chairman; Waldo McNeir, LSU; and Calvin Huckabay, Mississippi State University. To this committee was given the duty of nominating a President, Vice-President, Executive Secretary-Treasurer, and two council members for two-year terms and two representatives of the regional group to the RSA.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 12:45.
