

The Report of the Business Meeting of the Twelfth Annual
South-Central Renaissance Conference

The Business Meeting of the Twelfth Annual South-Central Renaissance Conference was held on Friday, March 13, 1963 in the Green Room, Oberholtzer Hall, University of Houston, at 1:00 p.m. .

President Richardson opened the meeting with an expression of thanks from S-CRC to Stanford E. Lehmborg, Program Chairman, and to Ruth Stickney and all who served on the Local Arrangements Committee for a splended program; to the University of Houston for their cordial hospitality.

The following business was endorsed:

1. The Conference voted and passed upon an amendment and an addition to the constitution as follows:

- a. By-Law 3 revised to read:

" The Local Committee may collect from those attending the Conference whatever registration fee is necessary to defray the cost of the meeting."

- b. Article V, Elections, add:

Section 5: The Executive Committee will select two delegates each year to the RSA, whose term shall be at the discretion of the Executive Committee.

2. The invitation to hold the Thirteenth Annual Conference in conjunction with the Renaissance Celebration of the University of Texas in Austin in April, 1964 was accepted.

3. An invitation to the Conference to meet at ^{Texas} ~~A. and M.~~ ^{University} ~~College~~ in 1965 was extended by T.J. Mattern ~~of~~ the Department of English.

4. The following resolution was read by the secretary:
