

Report of the Executive Council of the Twelfth Annual
South-Central Renaissance Conference

The Executive Council of the Twelfth Annual South-Central Renaissance Conference met at 10 p.m. on Thursday, March 14, 1963, in the Ram's Club, Houston. The following members were present: Walter C. Richardson, president; Lorraine Sherley, secretary-treasurer; Carroll Camden, Helen Thomas, Robert G. Collmer, Robert Pascal, members of the Council; Stanford E. Lehmberg, chairman, and J. Gordon Eaker, member, of the program committee; and Ruth Stickney, chairman of the Committee on Local Arrangements. The Vice-President's chair was vacant in memory of the late Dick Taylor, Jr. Thomas M. Smith and Willis H. Bowen, members of the Council, could not attend.

The following items of business were endorsed:

- 1). On hearing a letter from Archibald R. Lewis, the Council proposed that SCRC accept the invitation of the University of Texas to hold the thirteenth annual conference in conjunction with the Renaissance celebration to be held in Austin, sometime in April, 1964.
- 2). Ruth Stickney was appointed as the constituent delegate to the Southern Humanities Conference, Florida State University, April 5 and 6.
- 3). Miss Stickney proposed that a membership committee be appointed with the duty of increasing both the number of active members and the disciplines represented in SCRC. A motion stating that the president should appoint the committee, seconded by Standford E. Lehmberg, carried.
- 4). Lorraine Sherley was appointed to read Resolutions Memorial for Dick Taylor, Jr.

- 5). President Richardson appointed the following committee to nominate officers and three members of the Executive Council for a two-year term:
