



**SOUTH-CENTRAL RENAISSANCE CONFERENCE  
MINUTES OF THE GENERAL BUSINESS MEETING  
MARCH 31, 1989**

1. President Brown called the meeting to order at 11:30 p.m. and thanked the Local Arrangements Chair and Program Chair for their work in preparing an excellent conference.
2. The minutes of the 1988 Business Meeting were read and approved.
3. The secretary-treasurer reported that the mailing list contained 367 names and that membership was approximately 180; financially, he reported that SCRC is in good condition.
4. The editor of Explorations, Professor Fields, reported on the diversity of volume XIV and on his efforts to continue the interdisciplinary nature of the journal.
5. President Brown announced the Executive Committee's decision to accept officially the invitation of Memphis State University to host the 1990 meeting (with Professor Stagg as Local Arrangements Chair) and Loyola University to host the 1991 meeting. She announced that the Renaissance Society of America no longer plans to meet with SCRC in 1991. The membership applauded the forbearance of President Brown in dealing with RSA; and also voted to pursue a future joint meeting possibly in 1993. She announced that the Executive Committee will explore the University of Houston and Trinity University as possible meeting sites.
6. The Nominating Committee, chaired by Professor Anglin, recommended a slate of candidates for the Executive Committee that was approved by acclamation.
