



**SOUTH-CENTRAL RENAISSANCE CONFERENCE  
MINUTES OF THE GENERAL BUSINESS MEETING  
MARCH 24, 1990**

1. President Priest called the meeting to order at 12:57 p.m. and thanked the Local Arrangements Chair and Program Chair for their work in preparing an excellent conference.

2. The minutes of the 1989 Business Meeting were read and approved.

3. The secretary-treasurer reported that the mailing list contained 387 names and that membership was approximately 180; financially, he reported that SCRC is in good condition.

The editor of Explorations, Professor Fields, reported on the diversity of volume XIV and on his efforts to continue the interdisciplinary nature of the journal. He noted that Explorations was first edited by Marcus Orr of Memphis State University.

3. The Nominating Committee, chaired by Professor Anglin, recommended a slate of candidates for the Executive Committee that was approved by acclamation.

The president announced that the increase in dues apparently is having no adverse effects on membership; announced the appointment of Elizabeth Skerpan as editor of the SCRC Newsletter; announced Thomas Moisan as the program chair for the 1991 meeting with May 1st is the deadline for special sessions. Sessions of an interdisciplinary nature or those celebrating the 500th anniversary of St. Ignatius Loyola are especially encouraged.


5. The president announced that SCRC will meet in New Orleans April 4-6, 1991. No firm plans have been made for the 1992 or 1993 meetings. The Executive Committee received and accepted an official invitation from Chancellor Hurley of the University of North Texas to host the 1994 meeting. Lester Brothers and Eugene Wright will co-chair the Local Arrangements Committee. Negotiations have begun with RSA to host the 1994 meeting jointly. The Executive Committee agreed to give additional support of \$300 to Lester Brothers to meet with RSA in Toronto to initiate planning.

At the request of the Executive Committee, members agreed to raise the president's stipend for travel to RSA to \$400.

6. The president announced that David S. Berkeley has been named an **emeritus member**.

7. The meeting was adjourned at 1:17 p.m.
