



**SOUTH-CENTRAL RENAISSANCE CONFERENCE  
MINUTES OF THE GENERAL BUSINESS MEETING  
APRIL 4, 1992**

1. The meeting was called to order at 9:06 a.m.; the minutes of the 1991 business meeting were read and approved.
2. The secretary-treasurer reported that the mailing list contained 456 names and that membership was approximately 180; financially, SCRC is in good condition.
3. The editor of Explorations reported that volume XVII was the largest ever, with four articles on literature, two on music, one on theology, and one on theater. After discussion, members agreed to raise the annual subscription for the journal to \$10.00 for libraries.
4. The nominating committee recommended a slate of candidates for the executive committee that was approved by acclamation: Thomas Moisan for president; Herbert Turrentine for vice president; John Mercer for executive secretary-treasurer; James Baumlin (replacement term), Gloria Fiero, Craig Kallendorf, and Martha Oberle for the executive committee.
5. Old Business:
  - a. SCRC will meet jointly in 1994 with RSA in Dallas. We will also have some sessions at the University of North Texas campus. Lester Brothers will chair the local arrangements committee and Craig Kallendorf will chair the program committee for the 1994 meeting.
  - b. SCRC will meet at Trinity University in San Antonio in early April 1993; David Middleton will chair the local arrangements committee. Susan Krantz was named as program chair; May 1 was set as the deadline for proposing special sessions.

c. Members were encouraged to solicit invitations to host the 1995 meeting.

6. New Business:

a. James Potts and Jerry Holmes will be the new co-editors of the SCRC Newsletter. SCRC members expressed their gratitude to Elizabeth Skerpan for her efforts as editor.

b. The executive committee advised members that a proposed change to the By-Laws would be brought before them at the 1993 meeting, in order to allow the newsletter editor to become an ex-officio member of the executive committee.

c. SCRC members expressed tremendous gratitude for and delight with our hosts at Northeast Louisiana University for making the annual meeting so memorable.

7. The meeting was adjourned at 9:30 a.m.
