

SOUTH-CENTRAL RENAISSANCE CONFERENCE
MINUTES OF THE GENERAL BUSINESS MEETING
APRIL 9, 1994

1. Herbert Turrentine, SCRC president, called the meeting to order at 8 a.m. in the Southland Center Hotel in Dallas.
2. John Mercer, secretary-treasurer, read the minutes of the 1993 general business meeting, and they were approved. Mercer reported that the SCRC mailing list now contains 532 names and that paid membership for calendar year 1993 was 124. Mercer also reported that SCRC has \$2447.46 in a checking account and \$7039.53 in a certificate of deposit.
3. Turrentine announced that the 1995 meeting will be in Oklahoma City, hosted by the University of Central Oklahoma, with Sandra Mayfield as local arrangements chair. The exact dates will be announced in the fall Newsletter.
4. Turrentine announced that Gloria Fiero and Martha Oberle, who comprise the committee to recommend sites for future meetings, will make a report next year.
5. Turrentine announced that SCRC will, as before, offer a subvention of \$200 to the SCRC president to attend RSA in 1995 and a subvention of \$100 to any SCRC member who has a paper accepted for RSA in 1995 (and is the first to contact the SCRC secretary-treasurer).
6. Thomas Moisan, chair of the nominating committee, presented these nominations: Susan Krantz for president, Craig Kallendorf for vice president, and Liana Cheney and Christopher Baker for two-year terms on the executive committee. All were elected by acclamation.
7. Turrentine appointed Elizabeth Skerpan program chair for the 1995 meeting and urged members to submit suggestions for special sessions to her by May 1.
8. Turrentine announced that the executive committee has selected one of three applicants to be the new editor of Explorations and that the name will be announced in the fall Newsletter.
9. Susan Krantz, vice president, commended Craig Kallendorf, program chair, and Lester Brothers, local arrangements chair, for their fine work on this year's joint meeting with RSA.
10. Jim Potts, co-editor of the Newsletter, appealed for members to submit items for the fall issue by September 1, 1994, using, if they wish, his e-mail address: enpotts@merlin.nlu.edu.
11. The meeting was adjourned at 8:20 a.m.
